<p><u>GLASS</u></p> <p>All colors Rinse clean No lids Unbroken Labels may be on</p>  <p>Not acceptable: mirrors, ceramic cups and plates, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, heat resistant ovenware, drinking glasses</p>	<p><u>PLASTIC CONTAINERS</u></p>  <p>Rinse clean No caps or lids</p> <p>Plastics 1 through 7 No plastic bags</p> <p>Items which can be tied together (such as milk cartons) may be placed next to the bin.</p>	<p><u>NEWSPAPER</u></p> <p>Bundled and tied IN or OUT of the bin Keep dry</p> <p><u>MAGAZINES</u> <u>CATALOGS</u></p> <p>Bundled and tied IN or OUT of the bin Keep dry</p> 
<p><u>TIN CANS</u> <u>ALUMINUM CANS</u></p> <p>Rinse clean Lids off Do not have to be flattened</p> <p>Includes Empty aerosol cans</p> 	<p><u>CARDBOARD</u> <u>BOXBOARD</u> (cereal, pop etc.,)</p> <p>Must be flattened, bundled and tied, in 3'x4' sheets or smaller</p>  <p><u>OFFICE PAPER</u> In sealed clear bags</p>	<p><u>BATTERIES</u></p> <p>Please take to place where you purchase your batteries</p> <p><u>WASTE OIL</u></p> <p>Place in large container available behind Lift Station on Brewery St.</p> <p><u>FURNITURE,</u> <u>APPLIANCES, TIRES</u> ETC.</p> <p>Requires courtesy call to Town & Country Sanitation 800-626-1915</p>
